IBM DB2 Universal Database IBM DB2 Universal Database stores and retrieves all types of data used by WebSphere Commerce Suite, Service Provider Edition, including text, images, video and audio. The power behind the world's most demanding e-business applications, this relational database helps you and your customers securely complete transactions with consistent performance and reliability.

DB2 Universal Database includes pointers to images, macros, overrideable functions and HTML files. WebSphere Commerce Suite, Service Provider Edition uses the Open Database Connectivity (ODBC) and Java Database Connectivity (JDBC) standards to communicate with the database. IBM WebSphere Application Server IBM WebSphere Application Server provides a flexible environment for developing code that doesn't need to be rewritten each time you need a new application. Rather, you can reuse what you've already created — saving you development time and money. JavaServer[™] Pages (JSP) — used to create catalog pages — and XML — used for mass imports — enhance the open architecture of the server.

This provides new services and revenue opportunities, including revenue for every payment transaction.
